Registration for the contest will be start on Saturday, 10 December 2022, so eligible and interested candidates are requested to register themselves on the portal to take participation in any game/activity before the last date.

NOTE: The Date and Venue of the Competition are subject to change due to any unforeseen or unavoidable reason. No player or staff will have the right to object to this.

Competition Format:

The competition will be conducted in two phases:

- 1. Qualification Phase:** In this phase, the Player's Competition will be organized in each State and Union Territory separately.

2. National Phase: Each player selected in the Qualification Phase will be given a chance to compete at the National Level.

The Selection process of players for the National Phase

1. The players who finish the First Three Positions in the Individual Sports competition will get a chance to participate in the National Competition.
2. Whereas the First and Second Place holder teams in Team Sports will get direct entry into the National Competition.
3. Forth to tenth position holder players in Individual Games and Third position holder team in Team Games also can compete in National event but they will have to pay half of the expenses during the National Competition.

Terms and Conditions:

- a) Players can only represent their bonafide State/UT/Unit that is mentioned on their Birth Certificate.
- b) Players must be only Indian.
- c) A player can participate in more than one game but for this, he/she has to register separately for each game/activity.
- d) In a team game, a team can be formed by taking players from any Village, Panchayat, School, College and three or four Wards from any City/ Tehsil/ Taluka/ Block/ District. Only 2-3 additional players can be included in any team.
- e) Teams from sports academies are not allowed to participate in team sports.
- f) Students can download their GK Paper syllabus from the website or can also get it delivered in their mail on request.
- g) The weight categories of the weight-wise sports will be decided by the states before the start of the qualification stage.
- h) Cash prizes will be awarded only if there are at least 100 players in the Individual Event and at least 32 teams in the Team Games in the Qualification Phase. If the total number of Players/Teams does not meet the criteria, then half of the expenses of the National Games will have to be borne by the participating players.
- i) Players are required to bring their own sports equipment during the competition. The organization will provide only essential items.
- j) The Committee of Youth Overall Games Association reserves all the right to modify any Rules and Regulations at any time. In this, no player, coach, or person will have any right to object and all the Rules and Regulations will have to be strictly followed.
- k) Determination of Age Groups of the players for the competition will be as follows:

Individual Competition

1. Under-12
2. Under-14
3. Under-17
4. Under-19
5. Senior Open

Team Competition

1. U-16
2. U-19
3. Senior Open

Note: - Age will be calculated from 31st December of the year.

Documents:

The submission of the below-mentioned documents is mandatory for eligibility for participation in the competition. All participants are requested to bring two sets of documents given below along with the printout of their online application form, to be submitted at the competition venue.

- i. **Online Entry Form:** Duly signed by competitor, Parents, Coach, & Manager on the printout taken after filling out the official entry form online.
- ii. **Aadhar Card:** Two self-attested copies of the Aadhar Card. Participants are requested to bring their Original Aadhar Card with them and have to show it whenever asked by the authorities.
- iii. **Birth Certificate:** Two self-attested copies of Birth certificates attested by Gazetted officer. Only the certificate, which is issued by the Statistic Department of state/UT Govt. /Central Govt. or Municipal Corporation, shall be acceptable.
- iv. **Previous Year Exam Mark Sheet:** Two self-attested copies of the last passed class Mark sheet attested by the Gazetted Officer.
- v. **Latest Photos:** Two passport-size latest photos

Registration Fees:

To compete in the Qualification Phase, the Players will have to register online. The registration fee will be as given below:

- **Rs. 300/-** for Individual Games
- **Rs. 2100/-** for Team Games

Note: Players will have to register separately for different games. The registration fee will be same for both the boys and girls. There are No hidden charges other than mess charges in state level games.

LAST DATE: Tuesday, 28 February 2023; Late Fee: **Rs. 200/-** for Individual Sports and **Rs. 1000/-** for Team Sports till the start of competition.

Awards (Qualification Phase):

Individual Sports/Activities:

- First Prize: **Rs 21,000/- Cash** plus winning Trophy & Gold Medal
- Second Prize: **Rs 15,000/- Cash** plus Runner Up Trophy & Silver Medal
- Third Prize: **Rs. 11,000/- Cash** plus Trophy & Bronze Medal

Team Sports/Activities:

- First Prize: **Rs. 1,00,000/- Cash** plus Team Trophy & Gold Medals
- Second Prize: **Rs. 50,000/- Cash** plus Team Trophy & Silver Medals
- Third Prize: **Rs.20,000/- Cash** plus Team Trophy & Bronze Medals

OTHER BENEFITS:

- Apart from this, the first five ranked players will be given free training for one year at KSW Training Centre
- All other participating players will be given a 50% rebate on the training fee at KSW Training Centre
- State Level Certificate to every player

Note:

- If less than eight states participate in any competition in the National Games, then those games will be cancelled for that year or the Cash Prize not will be provided to the participating players.
- If a game is cancelled due to any reason, the registration fee of any player will not be refunded.
- National Event expenses will be deducted from the winning cash of State winner participant.
- Winning cash prize will be not given if any player does not participate in the national competition.
- Players who are participating in any two or more Track Events can form a team for Relay Race and participate in Relay Races without paying any Registration Fee. Only medals will be given to Winners of the Relay Race, there will be no Cash Prize for this.

Prizes at National Phase:

- ❖ Winner: **1 lakh Rupees Cash** to every player plus **Trophy & Gold Medals**
- ❖ Runner-Up: **Rs.50,000/- Rupees Cash** to every player plus **Trophy & Silver Medals**

Extra benefits:

- Free Accommodation
- Track Suits
- National Certificate
- Medical Insurance
- ID Card
- Dress Kit & Shoes

Note: The cash prizes are determined based on a deal with the sponsor. These can be changed, and they can be more or less.

Staff, Coaches and Referees:

We need staff, coaches and referees to make this competition a success across the country. Those who are interested to work in the field of sports, please join this biggest talent search sports festival. Therefore, if you are a sports related person and have a professional degree then welcome to India's biggest talent hunt sports scheme. To be a part of this competition, you must register 'as a member' on the official website of the organization today.

Facilities and Benefits

1. The coaches and employees whose duties will be imposed during the competition will be given a daily allowance of Rs. 800/- at the state level and Rs. 1200/- at the National Level.
2. Food and accommodation will be provided free of cost to all the members.
3. Each staff member will be given food and train travel expenses from his/her home to the competition venue.
4. Each staff member will be given a Tracksuit, a T-shirt, Sports Shoes, ID card, and a Whistle.
5. The best performing staff member will be given a trophy and an award of Rs 21000/- in cash separately for every game/activity.

Medical Services and National Accident Insurance:

- a. A Free Medical Insurance will be provided to each delegation and player during their travel & competition days.
- b. The Organizer will provide first aid support at the competition ground & in the hostel also during the period of the Championship. The Organizer has to inform of any medical treatment required when the delegations are at the hostel. Arrangements will be made to take the patient to the nearest local hospital if necessary.

Accommodation and Transportation:

- a. The Organizer will cover accommodation for each delegation including all players and all officials during the period from two days before to one day after the tournament.
- b. Participating State/UT/Unit will bear transportation expenses home to the venue & back.
- c. Teams who would like to arrive before or stay after the period of the Championship must inform the Organizer as soon as possible.
- d. The Organizer cannot guarantee the availability of accommodation at the designated hostel beyond the period of the Championship.
- e. The Organizer will provide transportation to all delegations according to the official schedule of the technical committee.
- f. Transportation will also be provided to and fro the hostel and training/competition venue(s).
- g. Transportation will be provided to all teams to and fro the venue, Railway station/Bus Stand terminals to the hostel (on arrival and departure).

Mess Arrangement:

Players who want to take the food facility during State Competition will have to pay Mess Fee at the rate of Rs. 200/- per day. The mess menu will be as follows:
